

# Handout

## How to make a Loop

1. Make squares. Write A (Answer) and Q (Question) on each card. The Q on card 1 with the A on card 2. Q on card 2 with A on card 3, etc. If you do it correctly – the last A will be on the first card – and you have made a loop!
2. Cut out the cards and give each player one or more cards.
3. Start with any of the cards. One starts reading the Q on his or her card.  
The pupil who has the correct A answers – and then reads his or her Q, and so on.

**Here is an example of a LOOP with six vocabulary words:**

<p><b>A.</b> I can: "å forsvinne"</p> <p><b>Q.</b> Who can translate "to travel"?</p>	<p><b>A.</b> I can: "å reise"</p> <p><b>Q.</b> Who can translate "to cause"?</p>	<p><b>A.</b> I can: "å forårsake"</p> <p><b>Q.</b> Who can translate "to pass"?</p>
<p><b>A.</b> I can: "å passere"</p> <p><b>Q.</b> Who can translate "to imagine"?</p>	<p><b>A.</b> I can: "å forestille seg"</p> <p><b>Q.</b> Who can translate "to return"?</p>	<p><b>A.</b> I can: "å komme tilbake"</p> <p><b>Q.</b> Who can translate "to vanish"?</p>
