

Handout Vocabulary Loop

1. Fill in questions (Q) and answers (A) on 6 of the cards. Then copy all the cards and give each player one or more.
2. Start with any of the cards. One starts reading the Q on his or her card. The pupil who has the correct A answers – and then reads his or her Q, and so on. If you do it correctly – the last A will be on the first card – and you have made a loop!
